## A Stroll Down Museum Mile City Carriage Tour

Along a single mile of Meeting Street you will find six museums, five historic homes and four scenic parks. After our carriage ride we'll head to the Powder Magazine, which is South Carolina's oldest public building (c. 1713) and served as Charleston's arsenal for storing gunpowder. Our next stop is the newly renovated and reimagined Gibbes Museum of Art. The Gibbes houses the foremost collection of Southern American art, and features working artists on its main floor. Lunch will be in the beautiful courtyard. As we head back up Meeting Street we'll visit the French Huguenot Church, the Old Slave Mart and the Confederate Museum. You're just steps away from the City Market and just one block from the best retail shopping on historic King Street.

*Tour will include a one hour carriage ride of Charleston's Historic District.
