A Trip Over the Cooper River Guided Motor Coach Tour

Your guide will tell you all about the stunning Arthur Ravenel Jr. Bridge as well as the Town of Mt. Pleasant, which dates to 1680. Your first stop is Boone Hall, famous for its dramatic and often photographed Avenue of Oaks. You will tour the house, cotton dock, and working farm, and stop for lunch at Boone Hall Farms. After lunch we'll venture over to Sullivan's Island where you can dip your toes in the ocean and visit Ft. Moultrie, where Edgar Allen Poe wrote his famous story, The Gold Bug. Ft. Moultrie was originally built of palmetto logs, and inspired both the flag and nickname of South Carolina, "The Palmetto State". We will then head to Patriots Point Naval & Maritime Museum, home to the WW II aircraft carrier USS Yorktown and the Medal of Honor Museum.
