Here you will learn the history of the plantation, from historical cotton farming and the lives of slaves and sharecropping to the mechanized and computerized farming methods used today. Head down Louisiana's Great River Road, where you'll experience fine dining and visit some of Louisiana's oldest antebellum plantation homes. End your tour in **New Orleans** where you'll have three fun-filled days with your Travel South friends!
