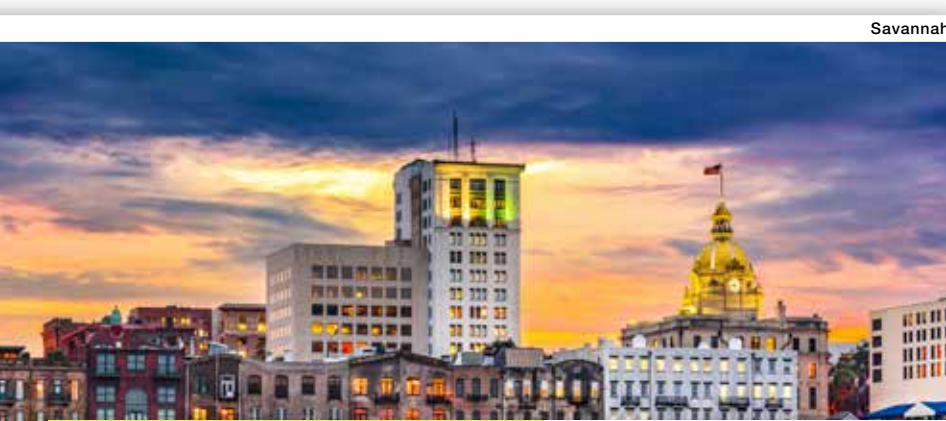

## SOUTH CAROLINA COASTAL BREEZES AND CHARM

### MYRTLE BEACH - ARRIVAL

**Day 1:** Myrtle Beach, the busy hub of fun-in-the-sun in the middle of the Grand Strand's 60 miles of gorgeous wide beaches, offers a dazzling variety of entertainment, nature, history and dining for people of all ages. Relax at the beach. Once there, spend the day building sand castles, boogie boarding and hunting for shark's teeth. The oceanfront Myrtle Beach Boardwalk runs along restaurants, bars, a fishing pier, an arcade and the famous 187-foot tall SkyWheel. Also, Myrtle Beach is home to the Broadway at the Beach, Alabama Theatre, the Carolina Opry and Ripley's Aquarium where you can experience authentic southern music and sea life.

### MYRTLE BEACH - CHARLESTON

**Day 2:** Head out of Myrtle Beach on HWY 17 towards the Hammock Coast, where you will step back in time when beaches were quiet places of solitude. Make sure to stop at Huntington Beach State Park where you can find three miles of pristine beach for relaxing, swimming or running and Atalaya Castle, a National Historic Landmark,

is an awesome sight to see. Just down the street you'll find Brookgreen Gardens, the largest outdoor sculpture garden in the USA, comprised of roughly 1,400 sculptures that dot the property and represent the works of every era of American sculpture from the 1800s to the present. Next, make a lunch stop in Georgetown and check out the harbor walk before continuing back on HWY 17 south towards Charleston.

### CHARLESTON

**Day 3:** Experience the charm of a historic Southern City Charleston combined with the contemporary vibes of South Carolina's coastal culture. With its second-to-none restaurant scene, beautiful oceanfront resorts and enduring cultural roots, the Holy City is a haven for history buffs and beachgoers.

### CHARLESTON

**Day 4:** Head towards Kiawah Island Golf Resort, which is situated on a 10,000-acre barrier island

Myrtle Beach



40 minutes south of Historic Charleston. Near Kiawah Island, on Johns Island is a small rural side road just off the direct route, this will take visitors on a short (less than one mile) drive down an unpaved road to the majestic Angel Oak. The magnificent tree is considered by many to be the oldest living oak east of the Mississippi, roughly 400-500 years old, it features a massive trunk measuring 28 feet in circumference and limbs that stretch out 187 feet (providing 17,000 sq. ft of shade). Drive through Wadmalaw Island, south of Charleston, to see Camellia Sinensis tea plants that grow at the Charleston Tea Garden and used in American Classic Tea, the only tea grown in America. Afterwards, continue north on HWY 700 E towards Charleston, take Ashley River Road from here to find Drayton Hall, Magnolia Plantation and Gardens, and Middleton Place where you can find moving experiences about African American slavery and the antebellum south. Next continue back to HWY 17, as this road takes you up the coast of South Carolina, where you can check Mount Pleasant and the Isle of Palms.

**CHARLESTON - BEAUFORT - BLUFFTON - HILTON HEAD ISLAND**

**Day 5:** Beaufort is located on Port Royal Island, one of the largest Sea Islands along the southeast

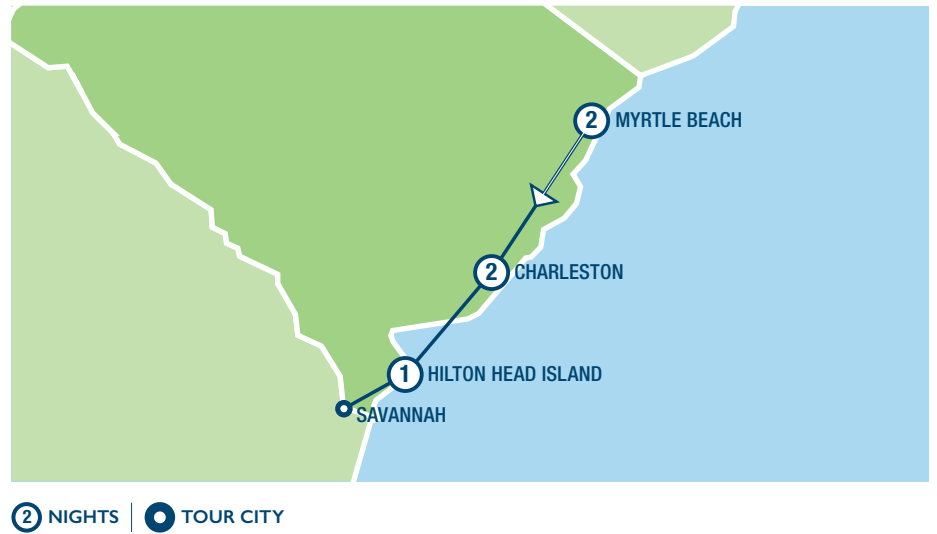
Atlantic coast of the United States. It is one of only a handful of U.S. towns that has had its entire downtown designated an historic district by the National Trust for Historic Preservation. This coastal town has a wonderful waterfront and restaurants serving fresh local fare. Bluffton will also take you back in time with its well preserved downtown on the banks of the May River. Take a walking tour and experience museums, art galleries and theatres. Close by is Hunting Island State Park with the state's only public lighthouse. Hilton Head Island is one of South Carolina's most luxurious beach destinations. Dotted with world-class golf courses, renowned restaurants, superb shopping and white-sandy beaches as far as the eye can see, this resort island is

just right for relaxing. In addition to its premier accommodations and scenic beauty, Hilton Head also offers an exciting cultural scene to explore. Discover the deep history of the Gullah, descendants of slaves who lived and still live on the coastal islands, and their deep rooted history in South Carolina's lowcountry. Also, be sure to view wildlife on a dolphin watching cruise and see why Hilton Head is one the top Islands in North America.
